

APRIL 9, 2018

The Greene City Council met in regular session on Monday, March 9, 2018 at 5:00p.m. at the Greene Community Center with Mayor James O'Brien presiding. Council members present were Marilyn Folkers, Al Zweck, Denise Shreve and Marnie Schmidt. Ben Backer was absent. Also present were Tim Joebgen, Whitney Middleton, Cory Wiegmann, Bev Schuknecht, Jayne Knapp, Fred Meyne and Roger and Dawn Van Etten.

Motion by Folkers/Schmidt to approve the agenda. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Shreve/Zweck to approve the April 9th minutes. Roll was called and the vote was Ayes: Schmidt, Shreve, Zweck and Folkers. Absent: Backer. MC

Mayor O'Brien stated that this was the date and time for a public hearing on the sale of property owned by the city. There were no written or oral comments. Public hearing was closed. Folkers introduced RESOLUTION 2018-09, A RESOLUTION FOR THE SALE OF CITY OWNED PROPERTY AT 201 N. 2nd STREET, GREENE, IOWA, BUTLER COUNTY, IOWA and moved for its adoption. Seconded by Zweck. Roll was called and the vote was as follows Ayes: Folkers, Schmidt, Shreve and Zweck. Nays: None. ABSENT: Backer. MC

Fred Meyne discussed implementing new policies for the use of the new emergency services building and equipment. It was suggested that a committee be formed for the purpose of establishing a policy for the use of the building and equipment.

Folkers introduced RESOLUTION 2018-07, A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF GREENE, IOWA SUPPORTING BUTLER-GRUNDY DEVELOPMENT ALLIANCE RURAL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT GRANT APPLICATION and moved for its adoption. Seconded by Schmidt. Roll was called and the vote was as follows AYES: Folkers, Zweck, Shreve and Schmidt. NAYS: None. ABSENT: Backer. MC

WHEREUPON the Mayor declared Resolutions 2018-07 and 2018-09 duly adopted. (Mayor's signature affixed and made a permanent part of these minutes.)

Motion by Zweck/Schmidt to approve a contract with Blacktop Services for \$23,606 for the 2018 seal coating project. Streets to be sealcoated are East South Street from High Street to Constien residence. East Traer from RR tracks to Courtland, West Iowa St. from Bluff to Freeseaman residence. Roll was called and the vote was all ayes. MC

Motion by Folkers/Schmidt to approve a \$200 donation to Butler County Visions of Well-Being. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Zweck/Folkers to approve a Class B Native Wine Permit for Darbe & Co. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Shreve/Folkers to approve Laura Schafer, Sarah Dralle and Andrea Gotto as new pool board members. These are 3 year terms and will expire on 12-31-20.

Motion by Folkers/Schmidt to approve the claims. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Folkers/Shreve to adjourn at 6:44.
