Motion by Folkers/Schmidt to approve the March 22nd minutes. Roll call, all ayes. MC

The council, Jamie Fettkether and Heather Prendergast reviewed an example of covenants and made changes that would apply to the elementary school housing project. A new version will be written up for this project.

Cory Wiegmann requested purchasing the following items from the 2020-2021 budget: pole saw – up to \$600; paint sprayer – up to \$875 and storage cabinets for lagoon bldg. – up to \$600. Motion by Folkers/Corwin to approve the purchases. Roll call, all ayes. MC

The Dry Run bridge project was discussed. An 8-foot sidewalk on the downstream side of the bridge was discussed. There will not be a sidewalk on the upstream side. This info will be passed along to the engineer.

Motion by Schmidt/Corwin to approve Advanced Environmental Testing and Abatement to remove the asbestos from the property at 12 High School Blvd. with a quote of up to \$3,000. Roll call, all ayes. MC
