The Greene City Council met in regular session on Monday, April 12, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. at the Greene Community Center with Mayor William Christensen presiding. Rod Fesenmeyer, Marilyn Folkers, Al Zweck, Marnie Schmidt and Ed Corwin were present. Sonja Hobson was present and Bev Schuknecht participated via Zoom. Cory Wiegmann arrived at approx. 6:00 p.m.

Motion by Folkers/Corwin to approve the agenda. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Fesenmeyer/Zweck to approve the March 29th and April 8th minutes. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Brook Schroeder was unable to attend tonight's meeting.

Sonja Hobson with Trees Forever spoke with the Council. This year there will not be a local sale as the extra trees are needed in the Cedar Rapids area due to the 2020 Derecho. Trees Forever however will be removing dead trees and replanting at the old community center lot, the park, the emergency services bldg. and some of the fruit trees on N. 2nd Street. Motion by Schmidt/Fesenmeyer to move forward with the removal and planting. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Mayor Christensen declared Friday, April 30th as Arbor Day and urges residents to support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands.

Zweck introduced Resolution 2021-07 – A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GREENE, IOWA SUPPORTING THE MARKETING OF BARE LOTS and motioned for its approval. Seconded by Schmidt. Roll was called as follows AYES: Schmidt, Zweck, Folkers, Fesenmeyer and Corwin. NAY: None. MC

Motion by Schmidt/Corwin to set Monday, May 10, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. as the date and time for a public hearing on the proposed CDBG Exterior Home Improvement &/or Architectural Barrier Removal Programs and a Community Development/Needs Assessment. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Folkers/Schmidt to approve the 2021 contract with Mosquito Control for \$4,215. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Cory Wiegmann asked for approval of 2021-2022 budget items so he can do ordering and scheduling. Motion by Zweck/Corwin to approve the following items:

- Seal coating - \$35,000
- City mower - \$19,000 (less sale of 2012)
- Well #2 maintenance - \$15,000
- Manhole lining - \$10,500
- Shop roof replacement - \$20,000

Roll was called and all were ayes. MC

Motion by Folkers/Fesenmeyer to approve the claims. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Fesenmeyer/Corwin to adjourn at 6:12. Roll call, all ayes. MC
