

JUNE 14, 2021

The Greene City Council met in regular session on Monday, June 14, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. at the Greene Community Center with Mayor William Christensen presiding. Council members also present were Al Zweck, Marilyn Folkers, Ed Corwin and Rod Fesenmeyer. Marnie Schmidt was absent. Also present were Mike Danburg, Bev Schuknecht, Christine Schultz, Leah Reser, Tim Joebgen, Matt Rust and Cory Wiegmann.

Motion by Folkers/Fesenmeyer to approve the agenda. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Zweck/Corwin to approve the May 24th minutes. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Corwin/Fesenmeyer to approve an agreement between the City of Greene, Iowa and Matt Rust for operation of a junk/salvage yard effective 6-14-2021 thru 6-13-2022. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Christine Schultz and Leah Reser spoke with the Council regarding River Days activities. The 200-300 blocks of North 1st street will be closed on Friday the 18th. The 100 block of East Ely will be closed starting Wednesday the 16th. The carnival will start moving into town as early as Monday evening. Their campers will be set up in the alley behind the old Express Mart. Motion by Corwin/Folkers to approve the street closures. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Mike Danburg, SEH, spoke with the council regarding additional charges for the N. 1st Street Project. Material testing, additional staking, sidewalk changes, storm sewer issues and contract/project time added to the expense.
