

**AUGUST 17, 2020**

The Greene City Council met in special session on Monday, August 17, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. via both Zoom and regular attendance with Mayor William Christensen presiding. Council members participating were Marnie Schmidt, Marilyn Folkers, Al Zweck, Ed Corwin and Rod Fesenmeyer. Also participating were Bev Schuknecht and Cory Wiegmann.

Motion by Zweck/Schmidt to approve the agenda. Roll call, all ayes. MC

Motion by Folkers/Corwin to approve the August 10, 2020 minutes. Roll was called and the vote was AYES: Folkers, Corwin, Zweck and Schmidt. Fesenmeyer abstained as he was not at the meeting. MC

Motion by Schmidt/Corwin to approve work change directive #1. This directive includes \$19,655.20 for ADA sidewalk ramp work and \$32,250 for storm sewer revisions. Roll call, all ayes.

Schmidt introduced RESOLUTION 2020-39, A RESOLUTION APPROVING 2019-2020 STREET FINANCE REPORT and moved for its adoption, seconded by Zweck. Roll was called and the vote was AYES: Schmidt, Zweck, Corwin, Fesenmeyer and Folkers. NAYS: None. MC

WHEREUPON the Mayor declared Resolution 2020-39 duly adopted. (Mayor’s signature affixed and made a permanent part of these minutes.)

Discussion involving having an ice cream truck come to Greene was held. The organization is asking the City to pay \$150 ‘trip fee’ charges before they would come to the community. After a brief discussion it was agreed that the City will not pay these fees.

Discussion with Steve Gilbert, Rural Housing 360 was not held as Mr. Gilbert did not join the Zoom broadcast as had been earlier agreed upon.

Motion by Corwin/Folkers to adjourn at 5:55 p.m.
